## Purpose of the position:

The purpose of the role is to lead community outreach activities related to clinical trials, engage with community advisory boards, and act as a liaison between the research team and the Ndevana community. The position will oversee the implementation of community engagement plans to facilitate participant recruitment, retention, and study accrual.

#### Scope of work:

- Implement community education and outreach programs in alignment with research protocols and Good Participatory Practice (GPP) guidelines.
- Manage the community team to execute recruitment, retention, and accrual strategies, ensuring study targets are met.
- Foster relationships with the community through advisory mechanisms, including supporting and liaising with the Community Advisory Board (CAB) and other stakeholders.
- Act as a link between study participants, research sites, and local healthcare facilities.
- Oversee and coordinate community health workers to ensure coherence with study targets and protocol adherence.
- Organize and execute community outreach events, awareness campaigns, and related activities.
- Stay informed on key research topics such as PrEP, STIs, HIV, and TB, ensuring the outreach team remains updated.
- Attend relevant training programs, workshops, and conferences.



- Contribute constructively to community education, recruitment, and retention programs.
- Assist with participant follow-ups, including call reminders for study visits.
- Facilitate and coordinate travel logistics for participants who have relocated to ensure study continuity.
- Plan and manage participant retention initiatives, including organising appropriate participant gifts and incentives while adhering to budgetary guidelines.
- Participate in meetings and internal FPD skills development sessions.
- Undertake additional duties as assigned by the Project Manager or Principal Investigators.

- Degree in Social Sciences or related field (essential).
- Certificate in Good Clinical Practice (advantageous).

### **Experience:**

- Previous work experience in community-based projects.
- Experience in implementation of community awareness campaigns.
- Proven stakeholder relationship management experience.
